## You will need

Music and a music player Space to move around A group of friends or family

## What to do

 Think of four Shakespeare Characters and decide on a pose for each character. Ideas include:

Romeo – climbing a wall

Bottom – donkey ears

Puck – picking a plant

Ferdinand – chopping up wood


- Practise making the poses for each character.
- Choose someone to be the leader. They must play the music and stop it at random intervals.
- When the music stops the leader calls out a character name and the rest of the group must make the matching pose.
- The leader decides who was the last player to make the pose and they tell that person that they are out. You can also be out if you make the wrong pose or if you move while the music has stopped.
- Keep playing until there is only one player left. That person is the winner and it is their turn to be the leader for the next game!
