³ Note - all years have been modernised so that March 1574 here was actually March 1573 in the parish register. The new year began at the end of March so that all births from January to around the end of March were recorded under what we would call the previous year. Years have been modernised to avoid confusion!



Anne Shakespeare (Hathaway), William Shakespeare's wife

Date of baptism: Unknown (supposed to be around 1556 from her age when she died, given on her gravestone).1

Date of marriage: Some point between 27th November (when the licence was issued) and 1st December 1582 (2nd December marked the beginning of Advent that year when marriages could not take place).²

Husband: William Shakespeare

Children (dates are of <u>baptism</u> and <u>burial</u> from the parish register unless otherwise stated):

- Susanna (26th May 1583 16th July 1649)
- Judith (2nd February 1585 9th February 1662)
- Hamnet (2nd February 1585 11th August 1596)

Date of burial: 8th August 1623

² Because we do not know where William and Anne married we also do not know the date of the marriage which would have been recorded in the parish register of the church in which they married. We know they did not marry at Holy Trinity Church unless, for some strange reason, the marriage was not recorded in the HTC parish register.





¹Holy Trinity Church parish register begins in 1558, Anne was born before this date and so her date of birth is not recorded.












Hamnet Shakespeare, William Shakespeare's son

The only evidence for Hamnet's short life are the entries for his baptism and burial in the parish register of Holy Trinity Church (baptism 2nd February 1585 - burial 11th August 1596). We do not know how Hamnet died. His death may have been caused by disease or accident. Like his father before him he probably attended the grammar school in Stratford-upon-Avon.
